



SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER



Loving God with all your soul and with all your strength is defined as "the first and greatest of commandments" and loving your neighbour as yourself, the "second commandment" similar to the first (Matt 22:37-39)

The great philosopher Kierkegaard wrote: 'Only when there is a duty to love, then only love is guaranteed forever against any alteration; eternally liberated in blissful independence; secured in eternal bliss against all despair'. The man who truly loves, wants to love forever.

Love needs to have eternity as its horizon, otherwise it is no more than a joke, a 'lovable misunderstanding' or a 'dangerous pastime',

as this philosopher, who himself had made human love a painful and profound experience, calls it. For this reason, the more intensely one loves the more distressfully he perceives the danger that this love of his runs, a danger that comes from none other than himself.

Help that comes from above, that heals our capacity to love wounded and weakened by selfishness, and gives constancy and perseverance. The evangelist John himself, who in the Gospel conveys to us the "commandment' to love, in the second reading also points us to the source where we can draw the strength to put it into practice. He says: "It was not we who loved God, but he who loved us and sent his Son as a victim of atonement for our sins... We love because he first loved us'. His Eminence Raniero Cardinal Cantalamessa.

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON

Proclaim a joyful sound and let it be heard; proclaim to the ends of the earth: The Lord has freed his people, alleluia.

FIRST READING Acts 10:25-26.34-35.44-48

As Peter reached the house Cornelius went out to meet him, knelt at his feet and prostrated himself. But Peter helped him up. 'Stand up,' he said 'I am only a man after all!' Then Peter addressed them: 'The truth I have now come to realise' he said 'is that God does not have favourites, but that anybody of any nationality who fears God and does what is right is acceptable to him.' While Peter was still speaking the Holy Spirit came down on all the listeners. Jewish believers who had accompanied Peter were all astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit should be poured out on the pagans too, since they could hear them speaking strange languages and proclaiming the greatness of God. Peter himself then said. 'Could anyone refuse the water of baptism to these people, now they have received the Holy Spirit as much as we have?' He then gave orders for them to be baptised in the name of Jesus Christ. Afterwards they begged to him to stay on for some days. The word of the Lord.

I have told you this so that my own joy may be in you and your joy be complete. This is my commandment: love one another, as I have loved you. A man can have no greater love than to lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends, if you do what I command you. I shall not call you servants any more, because a servant does not know his master's business; I call you friends, because I have made known to you everything I have learnt from my Father. You did not choose me, no, I chose you; and I commissioned you to go out and to bear fruit, fruit that will last; and then the Father will give you anything you ask him in my name. What I command you is to love one another.' The Gospel of the Lord.


COMUNNION ANTIPHON

A SOLEMN RECEPTION of the body of Bishop Peter will take place at St Francis Xavier Cathedral, 36 Harbour Street, Wollongong on Thursday 9 May 2024 at 6:30pm followed by Evening Prayer.

A SOLEMN VIGIL LITURGY will follow at 7:30pm.

A SOLEMN PONTIFICAL MASS OF CHRISTIAN BURIAL for Bishop Peter will be offered at St Francis Xavier Cathedral, Wollongong, on Friday 10 May 2024, commencing at 10:30am. Interment will take place in the cathedral grounds at the conclusion of Mass.

Relatives, friends, and the people of God are invited to attend the vigil and funeral. Due to the large number of invited bishops, clergy, relatives, dignitaries, and close friends attending the funeral, there will be very limited seating inside the cathedral. Therefore, a large marguee containing overflow seating with television screens will be erected in the carpark adjacent to the cathedral. Bishop Peter's casket will process past the marquee at the conclusion of the funeral Mass.
